1._____The introduction in my SEARCH RESULTS section contains a HOOK followed by a wellwritten thesis statement.

2._____I have at least one direct quote to support each assertion.

3._____I have at least two examples/evidence to support each assertion.

4._____Most of my examples/evidence is paraphrased.

5._____I have CORRECTLY cited the examples/evidence used within my paper.

6.____Each of my body paragraphs is organized according to AXES.

7.____Each body paragraph begins with an assertion/topic sentence which connects to my thesis.

8._____Each body paragraph contains at least two examples that support the assertion/topic sentence.

9._____Each body paragraph contain an explanation of how the examples/evidence connects to the assertion.

10._____Each body paragraph explains the significance of the information shared. In other words, I explained how the information connects to me/my thesis statement.

11._____I can clearly identify a variety of sentence structures within my paper (i.e., simple, complex, compound, compound-complex).

12._____I did NOT use 2nd person point of view (you, you're) when writing my paper.

13._____All of my quotes are integrated/introduced correctly.

14._____All of the sections of my I-Search paper are labeled and in bold print. The sections include the following: Introduction, The Search Story, The Search Results Section, Reflection

15._____My paper includes a correctly formatted works cited page that includes at least 6 sources.

16._____ALL THE SOURCES LISTED ON MY WORKS CITED PAGE ARE CITED WITHIN MY PAPER.

17.____ALL THE SOURCES CITED WITHIN MY PAPER ARE LISTED ON MY WORKS CITED PAGE.

18. _____One of my sources includes a personal interview.

19._____My paper is grammatically correct.

20._____I thoughtfully discuss a topic of my choice that is relevant to me and clearly explain the relevance.
